 - b. status of construction contracts, including the approval of any pay estimates, change orders and/or acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes;


- c. acceptance of site and/or easement conveyance for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, and the taking of any action in connection therewith;
